- b) **Riverbend Foodbank:** Local townships are donating funds to Riverbend Foodbank to offset delayed SNAP benefits.

- a) **Holiday Gift Card Program** - \$3,000 to be distributed to local schools for holiday needs – goal to help 2 families per school.

- a) **SNAP/Furloughed employees program update:** 1 voucher per house will be made available – coordination with Hyvee and other local townships – SMT to provide \$5,000, families to receive voucher worth \$250 – proof of eligibility required.

- c) **Rose Lawn Cemetery:** Attorney for SMT will be sending Greg the 7 steps conditioned for closing on property conveyance. This information will be distributed to trustees.
